Note - Please take a few minutes to read this manual. This will help you assemble and use the bassinet suitably. Keep this manual for future reference.

Before assembly, please double check all parts as shown are included in the package. To guarantee the service life of the bassinet, please use it correctly as per the instructions and make it thorough inspection regularly. Never use it if any parts are missing or broken.

For Your Child's Health & Safety

- To be used under adult supervision only.
- Before use, remove and dispose of all plastic bags and packaging materials and keep them out of reach of children.
- If a sheet is used with the mattress, use only a fitted sheet specifically designed to fit snuggly under all sides of the mattress.
- Do not place items in the bassinet with a string such as hood strings, pacifier cords, etc. Strings and cords can cause strangulation!
- Do not place anything in the close vicinity of the bassinet which can provide a foothold to the baby.
- To help prevent falls, Do not use this product when the infant begins to push up on hands and knees or has reached.
- Do not carry or move the bassinet with the child in it.
- Do not use accessories, spare parts, or any component not supplied or certified by Bonfino as they may make the bassinet unsafe.
- Keep the bassinet away from stoves, heaters, fireplaces and other hazards which can cause injury to your child.
- Do not place more than one child in the bassinet.
- Never use this product if there are any loose or missing fasteners, loose joints, broken parts, or torn mesh/fabric. Check periodically during use.

Assembly Instructions

Step 1



Unpack and take out the accessories.

Step 2



Lift up the pole.

Step 3



Unfold and completely open the bassinet.

Step 4



Install the bottom bracket on the upright.

Step 5



Place the screws.

Step 6



Secure the nut and fix it firmly.

Step 7



Press and hold the buckle to adjust the distance of the bottom bar.

Step 8



Pull up or down to adjust the brake.

Step 9



Open the side zippers.

Step 10



Press and hold the button to open the buckle

Step 11



Lay down the sidebar and make sure the bed is stable

Note

- 1. Always remove the cloth by opening the zipper sideways.
- 2. Pull the zipper from top to bottom in order to remove the fabric.

Height Adjustment







- The pull button is to be used for adjusting the height accordingly. The height can be adjusted up to five levels.
- The base of the bassinet can be inclined slightly by adjusting the two sides to different levels. This cannot be done when the bassinet is in sleeper mode.
- To ensure the safety of the infant, the maximum difference between the two sides is two positions. Always ensure that the bassinet is locked into the desired height placing the baby into the bassinet.
- DO NOT adjust the bassinet height while the baby is inside the bassinet.

Co-Sleeper Mode

- Adjust the bassinet height so that the top of the barrier wall is even with the top of the parent mattress. The bassinet must be set at an even height with no incline.
- Attach each of the bed straps to the buckles underneath the bassinet on each leg.
- Wrap each strap around the structure of the bed. If your bed does not have a box spring wrap the straps around the frame. If your bed has a box spring, wrap the straps around the box spring.
- Plug the end of each strap into the open buckles at the bassinet frame and pull the straps tight so that the bassinet is firmly pressed against the bed as shown. There should be little or no movement when finished.
- Make sure the zip-down wall is tucked between the mattress and bassinet and is not folded into the bassinet.

Wash Instructions

• Fitted Sheets

Machine wash cold and tumble dry low.

Mattress Encasement

Wipe down with a mildly soapy washcloth and hang to dry.

· Bassinet Lining

Unzip lining and remove from the bassinet.

Hand wash cold and hang to dry,

Do not use fabric softener, abrasive or aggressive products when cleaning the product Do not bleach.

Do not iron.

Do not dry clean.
